

License Agreement for OTA members
Organic Trade Association's Organic Fiber Processing Standards

The Organic Trade Association (OTA), located at 60 Wells Street in Greenfield, Massachusetts as sole owner of the following "Organic Trade Association's Organic Fiber Processing Standards" (standards) copyright 2004 has agreed to issue a copy of the standards to the following OTA member applicant company, provided the applicant agrees to the following:

- 1) The applicant company is an Organic Trade Association member and has paid all membership dues in accordance with the membership fee schedule.
- 2) The applicant company agrees not to distribute, photocopy or otherwise reproduce and distribute any copies of the standards to any other person or company without the expressed written permission of the Organic Trade Association.
- 3) If applicant company's membership to the Organic Trade Association expires, the applicant company must discontinue use of the standards and immediately return to the Organic Trade Association all copies of the standards (electronic or otherwise) within 30 days.
- 4) The Organic Trade Association, at its sole discretion, may revoke this license if the Organic Trade Association determines that the applicant company has distributed copies of the standards document or has otherwise misused or violated US copyright laws or the standards.
- 5) Any violations of US copyright law, as related to "Organic Trade Association's Fiber Processing Standards" will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- 6) If an Organic Trade Association member wishes to certify or be certified by a non-member of Organic Trade Association, the member must obtain a "non-member license agreement" from the non-member prior to distribution of the standards (see attached).
- 7) Upon being certified to these standards, the certified entity will have the opportunity to participate in future promotional programs in support of the standard. Until such time, the certified entity may use the phrase "Certified according to Organic Trade Association's Organic Fiber Processing Standards" on promotional materials in relation to products that have met these standards.
